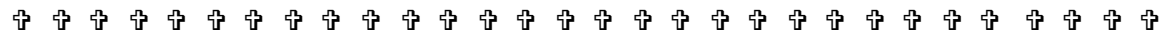
## GUIDES FOR WORSHIP
