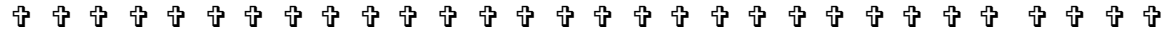

We pray in Jesus name. Amen

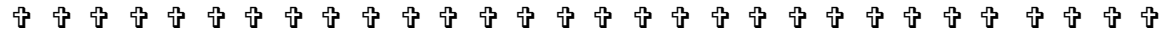
GUIDES FOR WORSHIP
