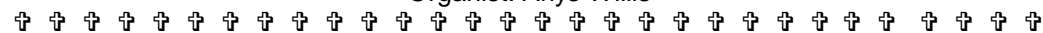

The order of worship begins with the baptism and then continues on page 154 in the front of the hymnal.

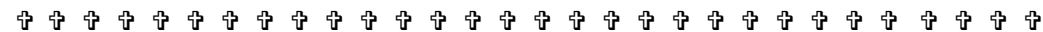
The Hymns are: 590, 442 (v.2 women, v.3 men), 531 (vs. 1-2)
