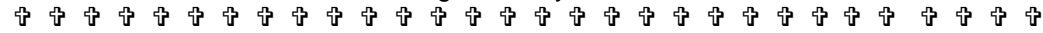

We pray in his name. Amen

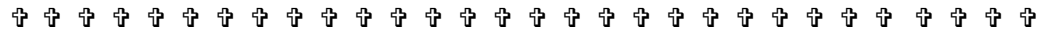

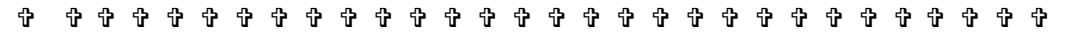
