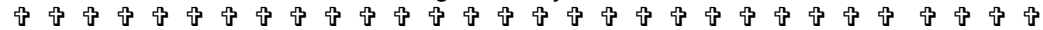

GUIDES FOR WORSHIP

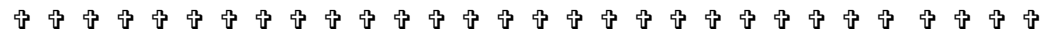
