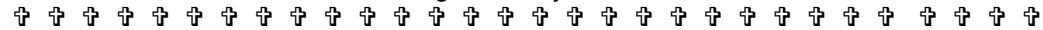

The Hymns are: 814, 714, 716, 664

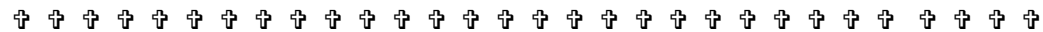
