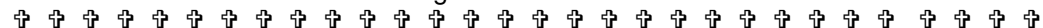

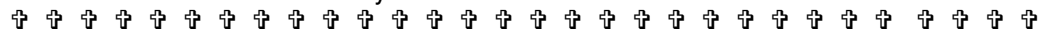
Sermon Text: James 5: 1-20
