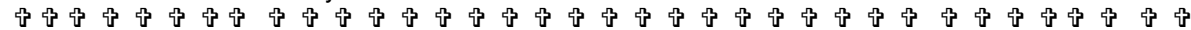
**GUIDES FOR WORSHIP**

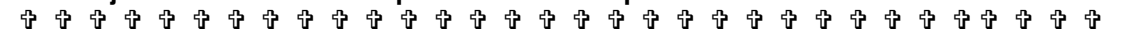
