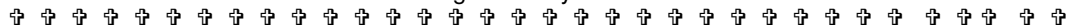

Help us not only to hear the words of Jesus, but also to do the things which He leads us to do. We pray in His' name. Amen

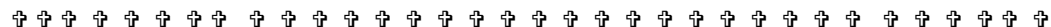
**GUIDES FOR WORSHIP**

**We ask high school seniors to plan ahead so that they can be recognized during worship at Peace on graduation day.**

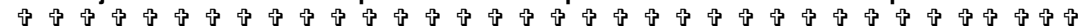
