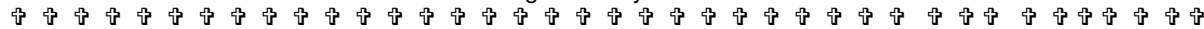

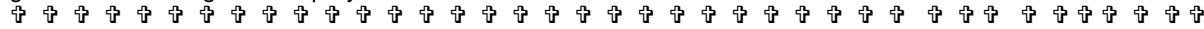

Move us beyond momentary “thank-you’s” to a place where our hearts consistently overflow with gratitude for Your gifts. We pray in Jesus’ name. Amen



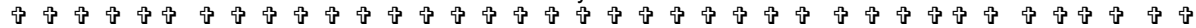
GUIDES FOR WORSHIP

Theme: “What Have You Done for Me Lately?”

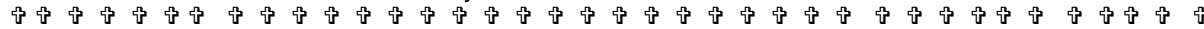
