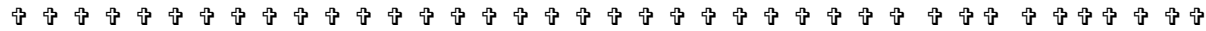

PRAYER

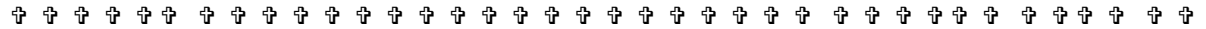
Lord, Help us to see ourselves both as sinners and as saints, so that we can live effectively for You.

GUIDES FOR WORSHIP

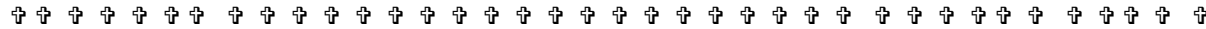
The order of worship begins with baptism and then continues on page 156 in the front of the hymnal.
