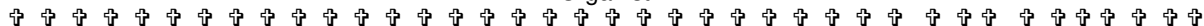

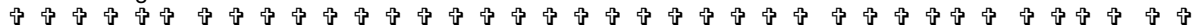
The order of worship begins on page 151 in the front of the hymnal. Holy Communion will be celebrated today.
