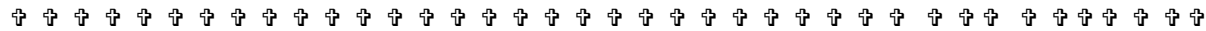

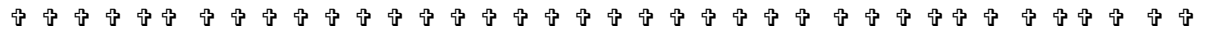

### GUIDES FOR WORSHIP

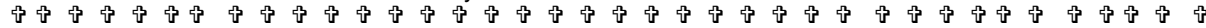
