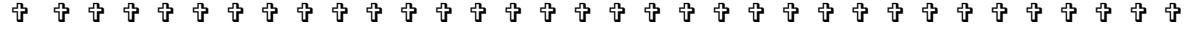

*White grape juice is available for those who prefer non-alcoholic communion wine.

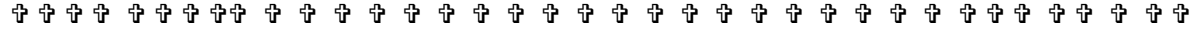
